

Steps to Install eSIS on your home computer.

Step 1: Un-Install Java 7. Java 7 cannot be installed on the computer, if Java 7 is installed the ESIS program will not work. To Un-Install Java 7 you need to navigate to control panel, and click on the Programs and Features Icon. Once open scroll down until you see Java 7, highlight it, and click "Uninstall" in the bar at the top of the window.

Step 2: Go and download Java 6 using the link below.

Step 3: Install the Java 6 program that you just downloaded.

Step 4: Create a new shortcut on your desktop pointing to this URL.
